

Design Statement

By name, by performance and by function, III Amigos is unmistakably a fish fighter and contender against all residents of the sea, however any preconceived images you conjure in your mind of her aesthetics and design, both interior and exterior, will indeed be defied.

III Amigos is truly unlike any other sport fishing vessel on the sea.

She is equipped with a Seakeeper 30HD Gyro and is powered by twin MTU 96L engines at 2,600hp each with MTU Dynamic Positioning.

A sport fisherman at heart the owner spared no expense when decking out the vessel with an abundance of space dedicated to the storage of rods and reels in the enclosed flybridge, diversified tackle storage and port and starboard jump seats with an elevation worthy of a command station, offering panoramic views of the ocean and its horizon.

Not one inch of the space is compromised for storage, and there are numerous creative forms of storage cleverly hidden throughout the vessel, making long expeditions possible.

And this is definitely a sportfisher an owner would be ecstatic to be aboard for any length of time.

Stepping inside the vessel, III Amigos's interior, analogous to that of a luxury megayacht, disports an impressive and dizzying level of details and unmatched personalization throughout.

The owner's enthusiasm for marble, rich leathers, and the love of European sports cars the likes of the Ferrari brand all played a part in the design of the space. With his main design request being "oneness with the water" with a light interior filled with depth and texture, he also desired contrast - a hallmark of his personal brand - dramatic and striking results reached by combining opposite ends of the spectrum.

It was with this theme of juxtapositions and contrast, both in design and with the intention of surpassing sport fishing yacht expectations, that the vessel truly took shape.

In every detail of the design Patrick Knowles created a marriage of materials and textures to satisfy the contrasting results the owner desired. A luxurious enclosed bridge

in teak and wenge conceals hardcore fishing equipment, while in balance of the vessel's interior, white washed and limed oak meets with dark wenge wood, navy and white, are punctuated with bright red accents, polished nickel, leather, quartz, and natural stone pair with intricate woodwork throughout, and so much more.
