




EXISTING FLOOR PLAN OF THE GAZEBO






EXISTING FLOOR PLAN OF THE GAZEBO (WITH NOTES)

- 7. Existing round dining tables.
- 8. Existing bar.
- 9. Existing pit to serve people in the water sitting at the bar.
- 10. Existing steps down to the bar service pit.




SUGGESTED FLOOR PLAN OF THE GAZEBO OBSERVATION DECK AND SWIM PLATFORM






SUGGESTED FLOOR PLAN OF THE GAZEBO OBSERVATION DECK AND SWIM PLATFORM (WITH NOTES)



- 1. Existing loose seating group.
- 2. Existing seating group with built-in benches.
- 3. Existing large central seating group with loose furniture.
- 4. Existing small dining table.
- 5. Existing loose seating group.
- 6. Existing seating group with built-in benches.
- 7. Existing round dining tables.
- 8. Existing bar.
- 9. I am suggesting filling in the pit that services the in-water bar and making it an observation deck. The floor will be like the rest of the inside of the Gazebo. This conversion will now create a useable and practical space next to the water.
- 9A: At the edge of the observation deck, I imagine that a pair of bar ledges with tall stools would be a great addition to this area. This will allow you to sit up high, right in front of the water. It will also allow those who do not wish to go in the water an opportunity to be with and interact with those who go into the water. The observation deck will unify those in the open Gazebo with those in the water.
- 10. I suggest eliminating the two sets of existing steps leading down into the pit that services the in-water bar. These areas will now be a flat floor like that of the rest of the Gazebo interior and will become the walkway that leads to the new observation deck.
- 11. Steps leading to the swim platform. These steps will be wooded and will be easy for your staff to maintain.
- 12. The floating swim platform that is directly on the water.
- 13. Two pairs of chaises with an occasional table in between each pair to place your drink.
- 14. Convenient stairs that lead directly into the sea. The steps will have convenient handles on each side to make it very easy to get into and out of the water.
- 15. One of your existing in-water tiki bars. (The 2nd tiki-bar is not shown; however it will most certainly remain as is).




SKETCH OF GAZEBO OBSERVATION DECK AND SWIMMING PLATFORM (1 OF 2)





SKETCH OF GAZEBO OBSERVATION DECK AND SWIMMING PLATFORM (WITH NOTES)




SKETCH OF GAZEBO OBSERVATION DECK AND SWIMMING PLATFORM (2 OF 2)


